With his advice, his help to create a proper CV for me and mock interviews we conducted, I got three internship offers from big companies in a couple of months and currently, I am doing an internship at Unilever.

As far as I see, the mentors at Be. Face are not some random people but volunteers who have impressive backgrounds and rich experience which make the whole program more valuable.

Our workshops

We organised 20 workshops with 175 attendants provided by 6 companies and Be.Face. We had 58 % of workshops on-site and 42 % in digital format with an average of 9 participants.

Our workshops have various objectives including the development of non-academic skills, a better knowledge or understanding of our member companies and of the business environment, as well as an increased readiness for a job or internship search.





- Contrary to what we might have expected, following the war in Ukraine, very few candidates registered.
- We noted that the job seekers' countries of origin vary greatly during the year, depending on our active partnerships. This year we had a significant proportion of Belgians.


This year we accompanied more job seekers than ever!

We also launched a very successful collaboration with the VDAB. We noticed than the majority of the job seekers joining us are mainly newcomers in Belgium, English-speaking, with a wide variety of backgrounds and of a higher age group than we experienced in previous years.








68% of our duos had a positive outcome, with 48% finding a permanent contract!





An initiative for equal opportunities with vocational purpose

Creating vocations through an early and 'funny' initiation of children to sciences is a common objective and common challenge for several of our company members.

This is an even bigger challenge for children studying and living in areas with a low education level and/or with low incomes.

In the Xperilab bus (Solvay), 5th and 6th grade students can conduct scientific experiments that can be reproduced in a classroom without risk and with cheap ingredients.

403 children from 10 different schools have already benefitted from this initiative.


